



FLOWER ARRANGING

Theme "Famous Events"

The whole of *Section A* is an open competition. Except where otherwise stated, any plant material may be used, including dyed or additionally coloured plant material. Artificial plant material is forbidden. Each exhibit to stand in a space approximately 2ft 6ins wide and 2ft 3ins deep, unless otherwise stated, against a background approximately 3ft high and off-white in colour. Nothing may be attached to the background. All exhibits must be assembled on the Showground unless otherwise stated.

Judged according to NAFAS Competitions Manual, Second Edition 2009.

Definitions of	'Exhibits'	The word takes the place of the words 'Arrangements' and 'Design'. An exhibit is plant material with or without accessories.
	'Accessories'	Anything other than plant material used as a part of the exhibit, EXCEPT BASES, DRAPES AND CONTAINERS.

The **DAFFORN CUP** is awarded to the best exhibit in Classes 1 to 3

The **JOHN B. NIXON CUP** is awarded to the winner in Class1

The **JUBILEE SILVER CUP** is awarded to the exhibitor gaining most prizes in Classes 1 to 3

15 "A Royal Occasion" – an exhibit. To be viewed all round. Staged on individual platforms 4ft (1.22 metres) square and approximately 4" (10.16cm) from the ground. Base covering to be provided by the Exhibitor. The exhibit to be staged by not more than two people.
