**Judging will be in accordance with the British Cactus and Succulent Societies "Handbook of Shows" 9<sup>th</sup> Edition 2003. Exhibitors are not required to be members of the above society and may enter any number of exhibits in a class, and win more than one prize in any class. Where given in the schedule, the pot size should be read as "up to and including the stated size".**

The trophies below are restricted to members of the Macclesfield and East Cheshire Branch of the British Cactus and Succulent Society.

**The WORMALD CUP** for the member gaining most points in Classes 99 to 118.

**The S. F. TAYLOR CUP** for the member gaining most points in classes 118 to 132.

**The TOM WILLIAMSON CUP** for the member exhibiting the best cactus in the Show.

**The WILBRAHAM CUP** for the member exhibiting the best succulent in the Show.

**A DIPLOMA** for a Junior Exhibitor gaining most points in Class 135.

**A DIPLOMA** for a Junior Exhibitor gaining most points in Class 136.

**The LEN ROWBOTHAM CUP** for the Beginner gaining most points in Classes 137 & 138.

**The RON GINNS MEDAL** for the member gaining most points in Classes 99 to 134.

- 103 **MAMMILLARIA group** – two plants – pot size up to 20cm.
- 104 **MAMMILLARIA group** – three plants – pot size up to 13cm.
- 105 **ECHINOCEREUS group** – one plant – pot size up to 23cm.
- 106 **REBUTIA group** – one plant – pot size up to 25cm.
- 107 **PARODIA group** – one plant – pot size up to 20cm.
- 108 **THELOCACTUS group** – one plant – pot size up to 20cm.
- 109 **GYMNOCALYCIUM group** – one plant – pot size unlimited.
- 110 **GYMNOCALYCIUM group** – two plants – pot size up to 15cm.
- 111 **ASTROPHYTUM group** – one plant – pot size up to 25cm.
- 112 **ECHINOPSIS group** – one plant – pot size unlimited.
- 113 **ECHINOPSIS group** – one plant – pot size up to 15cm.
- 114 **STENOCACTUS group** – one plant – pot size up to 20cm.
- 115 **ECHINOCACTUS group** – one plant – pot size unlimited.
- 116 **NEOPORTERIA group** – one plant – pot size up to 20cm.
- 117 **CORYPHANTHA group** - one plant – pot size up to 15cm.
- 118 **CACTUS or SUCCULENT – Cristate or Monstrous form** – one plant- pot size unlimited.
- 119 **SUCCULENT group** – one plant – pot size unlimited.
- 120 **SUCCULENT group** – one plant – pot size up to 20cm.
- 121 **SUCCULENT group** – two plants – pot size up to 15cm.
- 122 **LITHOPS sub group** - one container – longest side or diameter up to 30cm.
- 123 **MESEMBRYANTHEMUM group** – excluding lithops sub group – pot size up to 15cm.
- 124 **ALOE group (including hybrids)** – one plant – pot size up to 20cm.
- 125 **HAWORTHIA group (inc. hybrids)** – one plant – pot size up to 15cm.
- 126 **GASTERIA group** – one size – pot size up to 20cm.
- 127 **ECHEVERIA sub-group** – (including intergeneric hybrids) - one plant – pot size up to 20cm.

**128 EUPHORBIA group** – one plant – pot size up to 25cm.

**129 CRASSULA group** – (excluding plants eligible for class 127 and 132) - one plant – pot size up to 13cm.

**130 CRASSULA group** – (excluding plants eligible for class 127 and 132) - one plant – pot size up to 25cm.

**131 AGAVE group** – one plant – pot size up to 25cm.

**132 SEDUM AND SEMPERVIVUM sub-groups** – one plant – pot size up to 20cm.

**133 COLLECTION OF CACTI AND/OR SUCCULENTS** – the base of the pots to fit within a 30.5cm square – one plant per pot.

**134 CACTI AND/OR SUCCULENTS GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR FROM SEED IN THE LAST 5 YEARS** – four plants – one plant per pot.

**ALL SUCCULENT CLASSES above are to be read as excluding CACTI**

## JUNIOR CLASSES

**A Junior must be 18 years or under on Show Day. Age to be stated on entry form.**

**135 CACTUS** – two plants – pot size up to 11cm.

**136 SUCCULENT** – two plants – pot size up to 11cm.

## BEGINNERS

**A Beginner is someone of any age who may or not be a member of the *British Cactus and Succulent Society*. Entrants to the Beginners Section may compete for three years before being obliged to enter the open section.**

**137 CACTUS** – one plant – pot size unlimited.

**138 SUCCULENT** – one plant – pot size unlimited.

**ALL SUCCULENT CLASSES above to read as excluding CACTI.**
