



YOUNG PEOPLE'S NATURAL HISTORY

1. The exhibitor's age should be displayed on or by the exhibit.
2. The CHILDREN'S CUP is awarded to the person gaining the most points in all 4 young people's sections. (1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point)

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE THE YOUNG PERSON'S OWN, UNAIDED WORK CLASS

**257 COLLECTION OR DISPLAY of shells, flowers, grasses or leaves.
Open to young person under the age of 6 on the day of the show.**

**258 VEGETABLE ANIMAL OR GROUPOF ANIMALS made from any natural materials.
No artificial matter other than wire, pins or sticks to fasten parts together.
Open to young person under the age of 8 on the day of the show.**

**259 MINIATURE GARDEN – not larger than 45cms square.
Open to young person under the age of 10 on the day of the show**

**260 ARRANGEMENT OF GARDEN FLOWERS – height, including container, not more
than 15cms. Open to young person under the age of 11 on the day of the show.**

The following classes are open to anyone under the age 18 on the day of the show.

**265 A STUDY OF AN ENDANGERED ANIMAL OR PLANT.
Single sheet , booklet etc – no larger than A3**

266 MAKE SOMETHING USEFUL from waste material

267 GROW SOMETHING FROM SEED

**268 VEGETABLE ANIMAL OR GROUP OF ANIMALS made from any natural materials.
No artificial matter other than wire, pins or sticks to fasten parts together**

**269 DRAW A PLAN OF YOUR IDEAL GARDEN
max size 45cms square**

**270 ARRANGEMENT OF GARDEN FLOWERS height, including container
not more than 15cms**

271 MINIATURE GARDEN – no larger than 45cms in any direction.

272 A SAUCER OF MUSTARD & CRESS grown from seed.
